

# Natural Cleaning USER GUIDE

Welcome to the new clean

## GENERAL CLEANING TIPS

1. When cleaning, start with high areas then finish with floors.
2. Follow the product instructions. Use the recommended amount for best results.
3. Shake products well.
4. Do not mix products unless instructed.
5. For wood, antiques, or sensitive surfaces, test products in a small area before using. Spray onto cloth, not surface.

## CONCENTRATES & ALL PURPOSE

### Pure Soap Concentrate

- This is an all purpose powerful liquid Castile soap!
- A few drops for hands, body, pets, dishes.
- Add 30ml to a bucket for mopping, general cleaning with a cloth.
- Dilute 1:5 and add a bit of bicarbonate soda to make your own Spray-Deep.

### Daily Concentrate

- This is an all purpose powerful citrus vinegar concentrate. Repels dudu, good for grease and deodorizing.
- Add 200 ml to a bucket to use for mopping.
- Dilute 1:1 with water to make your own Spray-Daily.

## DEEP CLEANING DURING COVID19

1. Remove germs, dirt, and grime with soap like **Pure Soap Concentrate** or **Spray Deep**.
2. After soap, kill any remaining microbes on high touch areas with **Instant Disinfectant** after cleaning with soap.

\*Do not mix Grounded sprays with other products unless instructed.

## SPRAYS & SURFACES

## LAUNDRY

### Pre-Treating Stains

1. Fill the basin with water (~10 liters).
2. Wet and spot treat stains with **Grounded Laundry Bar** from both sides.
3. Add 1 liter of **Grounded Brightening**.
4. Add clothes. Soak for 1 hour. Dispose of water. Wring clothes. Wash in a machine.

Safety: When using Brightening, we recommend wearing gloves if hands are immersed. Keep out of direct sunlight.

### Machine Washing



Add 30 ml of **Grounded Laundry** powder to the washing machine tray.



If clothes are dull, add 60 ml of **Grounded Brightening** to the tray.



Add 120 ml of **Grounded Softener** to the tray (or as per washing machine recommendation).

### Laundry Bar

- Wet bar and clothes. Scrub bar directly onto stains, from both sides of the fabric. or use for handwashing.

### Stain Remover

- Shake well.
- Spray onto stain and allow to sit before washing.
- For serious stains, see our laundry guide.

### Spray – Deep

- All Purpose soap-based spray. Great for bathrooms and major cleanups.
- Shake well. Spray onto surface, or onto damp cloth then wipe surface. Super strong!

### Spray – Daily

- All Purpose infused citrus vinegar spray great for regular surface cleaning and deodorizing.
- Shake well. Spray onto surface. Wipe with damp cloth.
- Do not use exposed concrete or stone as it may stain or etch over time.

### Windows & Mirrors

- Shake well. Spray onto the surface. Wipe dry.
- Tip: Wipe with newspaper for best results.

### Scouring Powder

- Sprinkle on surfaces with hard-to-clean stains and spots, i.e. pots, pans, grout, tile, toilets, etc.
- Use sponge, steel wool, or brush and a bit of water to bring to suds. Rinse.

### Instant Disinfectant

- Spray onto handles, taps, light switches, cutting boards.
- Can even be used on hands or as a first-aid spray.

### Toilets

- Shake well. Lightly squeeze 1 circle around the toilet bowl. Scrub to suds and let sit while cleaning the rest of the bathroom. Flush. Works well with Scouring Powder.

### Dishes

- Use a damp sponge; not dripping. Wipe across top of soap and work into foam.
- At the end of washing, dump excess soapy water from the tub into the sink or basin.
